This event will take place on 26 April 2013at Delta Nova-Comoro.

In relation to the celebration of this anniversary, JSMP will also conduct a debate between the Faculties of Lawfrom the universities of UNTL, UNPAZ, UNDIL and UNITAL at Delta Nova, Comoro, Dili.The topic of the debate is "*Incestin Timor-Leste is a crime thatis not yet provided for in a specific law*".

The aim of this debate is to hear the academic perspective about incest. Another objective is to seek and develop alternative steps to strengthen protection for victims and to ensure that appropriate punishments exist for perpetrators.

"JSMP is certain that this debate can produce a range of options and alternatives on how to influence the competent authorities, strengthen protection for victims and to provide an opportunity to amend thePenal CodeandLawAgainst Domestic Violence to include provisions on incest" said theExecutive Directorof JSMP, Luis de Oliveira Sampaio.
